

SHOW RULES

1. USEF Rules are to apply except where otherwise noted.
2. RIDING APPAREL: English/Western Riders must wear boots and sleeved shirts. Helmets (ASTM Approved) or hats must be worn. Chaps and hunt coats are optional.
3. Training Equipment: Hackamores (bosal), snaffle bits and training aids (i.e., draw reins, running martingales, German martingales) are permitted. No mechanical hackamores allowed. Two hands may be used on reins.
4. Stallions may not be shown by rider/handlers under 18 years of age.
5. Parents/Trainers will supervise children and their mounts at all times.
6. Ponies are allowed in all classes.
7. Dogs and all other pets must be kept on leash at all times.
8. Classes with less than three entries may be canceled or combined.
9. Lead line riders may not enter any other riding classes.
10. Walk/Trot class entries may enter other classes in the show.
11. One-minute gate rule will be strictly enforced.
12. Color class: Open to appaloosa, buckskin, dun, paint, pinto and palomino horses. Excludes: gray, bay, black and chestnut horses.
13. Separate entry form for same rider on second horse.
14. Non-Competitive Riders may enter any class at regular fee. Exhibitor Number to be worn upside down.
15. Halter championship: 1st and 2nd place winners from each class to advance.
16. Halter classes do not count toward high point.

FOR THE SAFETY OF ALL

Exhibitors will not be allowed to unhook trailers on show grounds.
Lounging in 50" Round pen only.
Disruptive/Unruly/Abusive behavior of animals or people will be cause for expulsion from show grounds with no refund of entry fees.
